Why aren't you searching Voter Records?

The Voter Records Category was added in April, 2019 and updated in October, 2020. At worst, they can tell you of the location of an ancestor you might be researching. Some lists are just names of people who were registered to vote at a particular time. But some voter registers have an abundance of information and can tell you:

- Where they were in between censuses
- Naturalization information
- Middle names
- Physical Characteristics
- Name of spouse
- Naturalization and migration information

Try it out!

Newspapers especially, but often other important genealogy related documents, used abbreviations. Make sure you include these abbreviations in your search criteria as well as the entire word. And don't forget nicknames! Here are some examples

- Eliz for Elizabeth
- Wm for William
- Sgt for Sergeant
- Ave for Avenue
- Corp for Corporation
- Jno for John
- St for Street
- NYC for New York City
- Jos for Joseph
- Abe for Abraham

- Capt for Captain
- Pl for Place
- Co for Company
- Pres for President
- Meg or Maggie for Margaret
- Molly for Amelia
- Dot for Dorothy
- Ln for Lane
- Col for Colonel
- Jack for John
