





### **Genealogy Facts**

No, your ancestors names were not changed at Ellis Island. Names were written down in a ship manifest prior to the arrival in New York. Registry clerks just checked the names. Changes to Anglicized names were generally done later by your ancestor, often during the naturalization process.

## History Hub - A Crowdsourced History and Genealogy Research Platform

Have you checked out History Hub (<a href="https://historyhub.history.gov">historyhub.history.gov</a>) to visit their communities and ask questions that could help further your genealogy research?

History Hub is sponsored by the National Archives and was developed by them in 2016 as a community crowdsourced support platform where people can ask questions, get help with research and share their knowledge and information they have. National Archive staff respond to many of the questions with information about resources found at the National Archives and sometimes include information about other resources. Genealogists, citizen archivists, historians, etc. are also welcomed to help answer questions. There are 19 community pages which are listed below. On the community pages you will find an overview, existing questions and answers, a place to ask your question, and links to relevant blog posts.





## **Genealogy Did You Know?**

### Genealogy Did You Know

When searching for a surname, have you searched for hyphenated words? In old newspapers, hyphens were used a lot. For a name like "Montgomery", search the entire string, but also "Mont" or "gom" or "gomery" or "ery". You will get as much as 30% more pertinent results.

### Genealogy Did You Know

When searching for obituaries, include a couple of weeks after the death of the ancestor. Many times the obituary publication was delayed, but more importantly, some obituaries were changed after their original publication, because of errors, modifications or additions. So don't stop searching after you have found the first one.

### Genealogy Did You Know

Make sure that you search for state abbreviations in addition to full state names. One caution, we've only had two digit state abbreviations since 1963. Prior to that year, the states were abbreviated "Calif.", "Kans.", Fla.", "Ill.", "Mass", etc.

### Genealogy Did You Know

A marriage is not a marriage if it is listed in old newspapers in the "Marriage Licenses Issued" or "Intentions to Wed" column, or if in the Women's or Society section an engagement is announced. If that's all you have, it is only a clue to a potential marriage.

When you are searching for obituaries in old newspapers, if you add "beloved" or "loving" or "dear" or "devoted" or "passed away" or "died" or "funeral" to your search criteria, you are more likely to find the Obituary section of the paper and hence more likely to find your target obit

### Genealogy Did You Know

Search old newspapers using abbreviations for names and titles. For example, "Wm" for "William", "Jos" for "Joseph", "Eliz" for "Elizabeth", and "Robt" for "Robert", just to name a few. Also, "Sgt" for "Sargeant" and "Ave" for "Avenue", etc.






